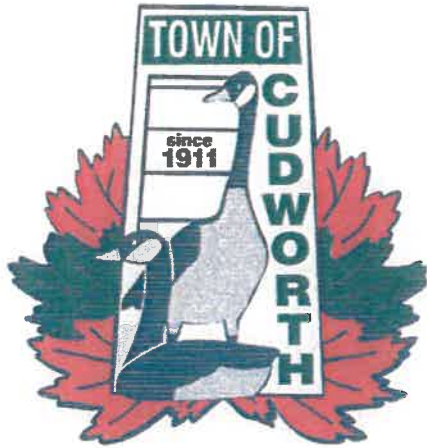


## Town of Cudworth Mission Statement

### Community Development

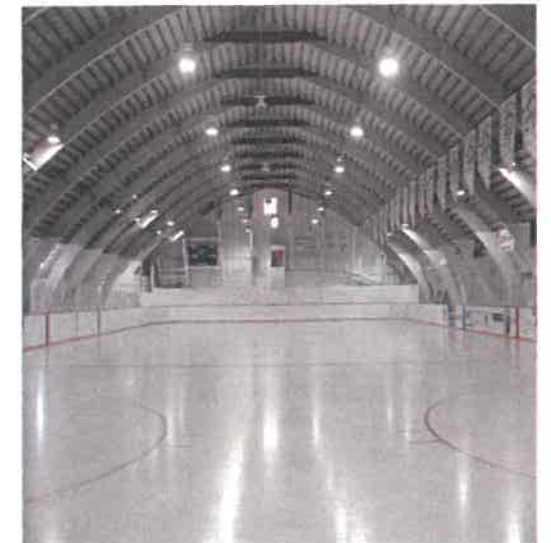
- promote active community based participation in issue and problem identification and resolution

## Implementation of the Plan 2004-2017 Major Projects Completed

### Infrastructure Management

- upgraded Town facilities including: community hall, arena, swimming pool, town shop, quonset, storage garage, curling rink, doctors house, 3 cell lagoon, library, fire hall, lift stations, Town office, museum and waterplant, expansion of water and sewer services and street reconstruction
- waterplant - installation of a standby generator and roof replacement
- 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue lift station - installation of a standby generator
- equipment purchased - mower, emergency vehicle, grader, sand spreader and backhoe
- replacement of sewer force main and main street water valves
- expansion of water and sewer services
- street reconstruction
- new access road
- purchase of new fire truck and equipment
- swimming pool - complete refurbishment including liner, filters, plumbing, concrete deck and sidewalk
- arena - installation of artificial ice, painting, shingles and new flooring and kitchen

- library - major renovation including windows, siding, sidewalk, bathrooms, flooring, painting and furnishing
- museum - baggage room converted to museum display space and addition of a gazebo
- ball park - new fencing, wind shelter and playground
- curling rink and pool building - shingles
- new Cudworth entrance sign
- centennial park - new playground equipment
- flood drainage - installation of culverts and improved drainage
- sidewalk replacement - 100 block of Main Street, 500 block of Main Street and 400 block of 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue
- replacement of sewer force main and main street water valves

Priorities for 2018 to 2023**

**Quality Service**

- continued maintenance of our quality water/wastewater system
- provision of quality regular service including grass cutting, street maintenance, drainage, snow removal and garbage collection, etc.
- continued updates and changes to the Emergency Measures Policy and Manual
- continued maintenance of recreational facilities and equipment

**Community Development**

- development of a lot sales campaign
- circulation of regularly publicized community newsletters
- CTV Hometown Tour 2010
- 2011 Centennial Celebrations DVD
- development of community brochure and website townofcudworth.com

**Economic Viability**

- design and development of a community promotion brochure, website and signage
- establishment of the Cudworth Recreational Lottery campaign

**Fiscal Responsibility**

- budgeting includes long term financial planning, vigorous monitoring of financial operations and focus on fee for service funding
- installation of high efficiency furnaces and lighting systems in Town facilities
- computer hardware and software upgrades and staff training
- initiated establishment of regional economic planning and development association
- continuing focus to maximize senior government grants through partnership projects for water/sewer upgrade, street reconstruction, paving, access road, student employment grants and museum operating grant
- completion of the asset evaluation and Management plan, zoning bylaw and our Official Community Plan in 2016
- negotiation of a new airport agreement with the Saskatoon Soaring Club

**Quality of life**

- provided effective leadership during the flood of June, 2005 followed by flood prevention measures in 2006 and 2007, construction of a catch basin in 2011 and continued drainage improvement
- established Cudworth Community Health Council
- membership in the Cudworth/Wakaw/RM health councils

**Cooperative Spirit**

- provided leadership for the highly successful 2005 and 2011 Centennial Celebrations involving the entire Cudworth community
- successfully secured major donations for the hall roof and swimming pool
- focused on team approach to establish close working relationships between Council, staff and the community, built strong foundations based on trust, honesty and respect

**Town Essential Services and Projects**

- ★ paving of 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Avenues and Saskatchewan Street
- ★ refurbish cell 3 of lagoon system
- ★ repair of sidewalks/ replace sidewalk 100 block of King Street and 400 block of 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue
- ★ chip seal low traffic streets/pave high traffic streets
- ★ Shingling of the arena main roof

**Community Funded Recreation Projects**

- ★ replace hall flooring/install new cupboards & counter tops/install new shutters
- ★ upgrades to campground buildings
- ★ refurbish mushroom pool
- ★ hall barrier free restroom
- ★ ongoing fundraising campaign for artificial ice
- ★ update to Community Activities Board
