### **ARENA**

We are busy preparing for the upcoming arena season. Kirk Medernach is returning as caretaker and Bonnie Hauber will again lease the kitchen. Ice making will begin October 1<sup>st</sup> with plans of having the ice ready October 15<sup>th</sup>. ### **COMPOST**

Please have your compost material in the back lane by October 17<sup>th</sup>. The piles of compost must be accessible and cannot be placed around power poles etc. The bucket of the skid steer is 5' so the location must accommodate our equipment. The crew will not pickup tree branches that are longer than 5'. If you have bigger branches, you can call the office and ask for the garbage truck and load them directly. We cannot pickup plastic garbage bags so please have everything loose or in compostable paper bags.

**Remember, React has implemented changes to our compost collection. Your compost piles must be separated into 2 piles with garden refuse in one pile and wood/trees in another pile. If you mix all your compost and wood together React will not accept it and we will be unable to pick it up.**

## **WILDLIFE**

### **Skunks - Things You Should Know**

- Deter skunks by setting up motion-activated lights and sprinklers. ...
- Remove food sources by securing your trash and pet food, and keeping your yard free of bird seed and grubs.
- Seal off small areas with chicken wire, and use skunk repellent or ammonia-soaked rags to deter skunks with smell.
- If all else fails, contact a professional to trap and release the skunk away from your property.

**Do not feed animals** that are likely to become a problem for you or your neighbours, whether in yard, the local park or other greenspaces. Wild animals should not depend on humans for their food, and should not learn to expect food from us. It could put them at risk of being hurt or killed if they start approaching people aggressively in search of food. Please eliminate all outdoor food sources such as produce from fruit trees and stop feeding pets outside.

### **DOGS RUNNING AT LARGE**

We have had several recent occurrences where dogs have attacked or acted in an aggressive manner toward the general public. We remind you that pets must be on a leash and restrained at all times when they are not on private property. Please ensure fences/kennels or any other means of restraining animals are secure and not in disrepair. For public safety, please report any incidents regarding animals at large to the Town Office so we can address these issues. Concerns are referred to the Bylaw Enforcement Officer or RCMP.

Cudworth does not have any designated off leash areas so when walking your dog please ensure it is on a leash and controlled at all times and that you **CLEAN UP** after your pet. Please be responsible pet owners and consider others walking behind you.

### **SNOW REMOVAL**

During the winter months we need to keep our streets clear of vehicles for snow removal purposes. Please keep vehicles not used daily off the streets so we can properly clear the snow when necessary. You are reminded not to place snow from driveways or sidewalks onto the streets. Also, we would appreciate your cooperation in moving your vehicle when you see the public works crew clearing your area.
